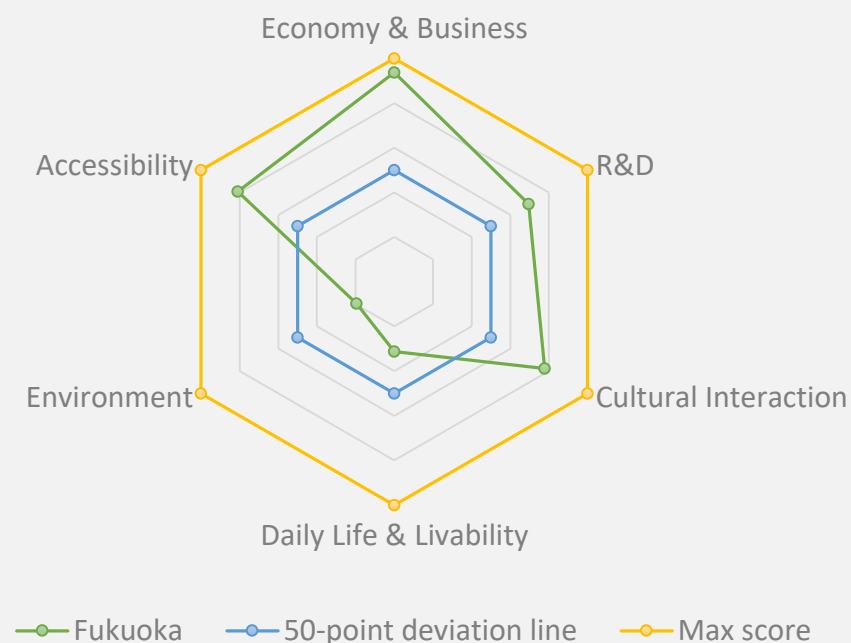


OSAKA

A vibrant city in the Kansai region and an economic powerhouse in Japan.

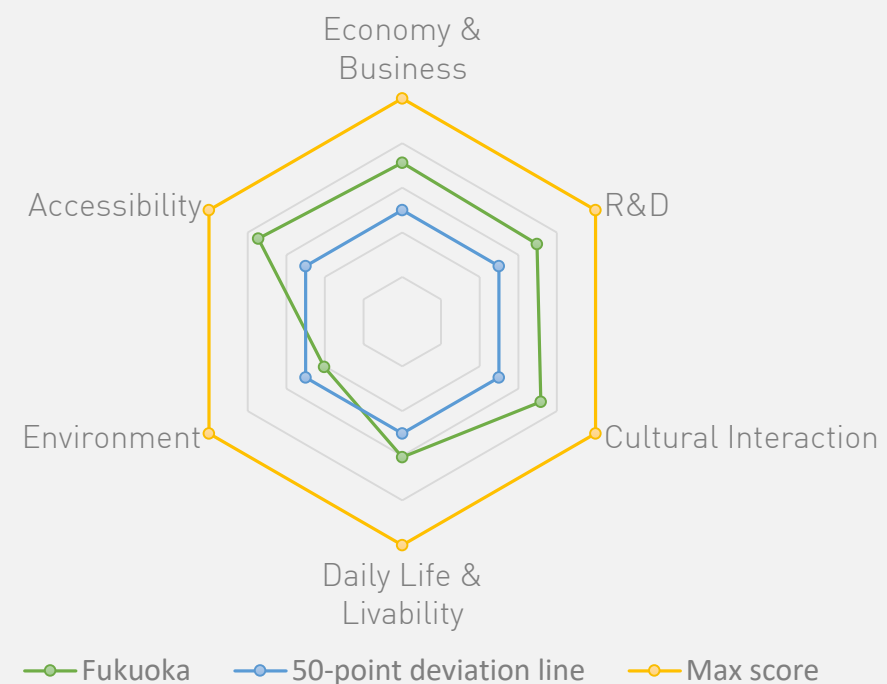


FUKUOKA
